## What I should already know?

## Knowledge

There are twelve months of the year.

There are four seasons which we can split the year into.

The temperature, amount of sunshine and rain change over the year.

We can record the weather in journals and diaries.

Just like with maps symbols for the weather can be used to show information.

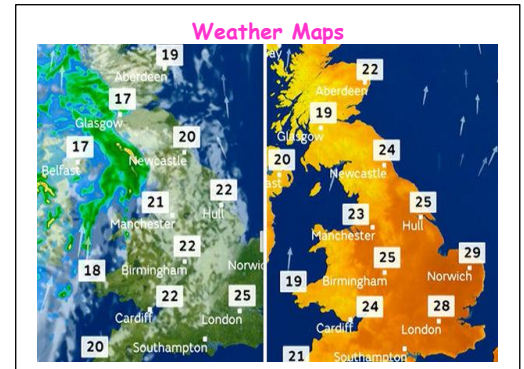
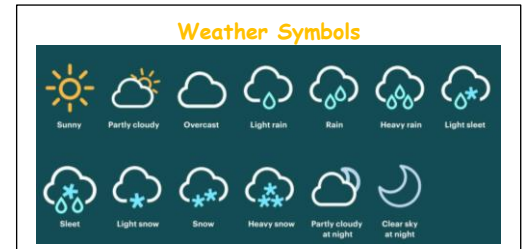
## What I will know by the end of this unit?

## Vocabulary

<b>climate</b>	The usual weather conditions of an area
<b>drought</b>	When there is no rainfall for a long time.
<b>heatwave</b>	Unusually hot weather over a long period.
<b>weather forecast</b>	A prediction of what the weather will be like in the future.
<b>symbols</b>	Pictures or signs that help us understand something.
<b>extreme</b>	Beyond what is normal.
<b>seasons</b>	The year is divided into four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter
<b>temperature</b>	A measure of how hot or cold something is
